**PROCLAMATION.**

PALESTINE.

(Gazette 16th March, 1934).

BY HIS EXCELLENCY JOHN HATHORN HALL ADMINISTERING THE GOVERNMENT  
OF PALESTINE.

J. HATHORN HALL  
*Officer Administering the Government.*

**Whereas** by an Order-in-Council of His Majesty King George V. dated the tenth day of August, 1922, it is ordered, *inter alia*, that if the High Commissioner be absent from Palestine, the person appointed to be Chief Secretary to the Government of Palestine shall, during His Majesty's pleasure, administer the Government of Palestine, first having taken the oaths in the said Order directed to be taken by the High Commissioner and in the manner therein prescribed, which having been done, the Chief Secretary is by the said Order authorised, empowered and commanded to do and execute during His Majesty's pleasure all things that belong to the office of the High Commissioner according to the tenor of the said Order and according to His Majesty's instructions and the laws of Palestine;

**And whereas** His Excellency the High Commissioner is absent from Palestine and I have this day taken the said oaths;

**Now, Therefore,** I, JOHN HATHORN HALL, Companion of the Most Distinguished Service Order and Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Military Cross, Chief Secretary to the Government of Palestine, do hereby proclaim that I have this day assumed and taken over the administration of the Government of Palestine, and I do hereby enjoin all officers of the Government, civil and military, and all inhabitants of Palestine to take notice thereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.

Given at Jerusalem, the sixteenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.
